Duke of Edinburgh

Hove Park School is an officially licensed provider of the Duke of Edinburgh award

Bronze

In Year 9 we offer the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award. Students complete four sections. It is made up of three sections completed independently: a physical activity, volunteering and a skill, which in all cases can be something they already do, or something new, each once a week for at least three months, with one extended. However, the school will help identify possible activities, advise on who can assess their achievements and help them complete their e-log so they can achieve the award. The school oversees the expeditions and training for them. The Bronze practice and assessed expeditions take place in the summer term and both of these take place nearby, on the South Downs.

Silver

In Year 10 we offer the Duke of Edinburgh Silver Award. Students can enter straight to Silver, or continue from Bronze. The Silver Award is also made up of three sections, completed independently for slightly longer. Directly entering students complete a longer time in one section. The school will help in the same way to achieve the award.

The school oversees the expeditions and training for the students. The Silver practice expedition takes place in April Year 10 in the Ashdown Forest and the assessed expedition takes place in September in Year 11.

Gold

In the 6th Form we offer the Gold award. Students can enter straight to Gold, without having completed Silver, or continue from Silver. The Gold award is also made up of the usual three sections completed independently. In addition, candidates undertake a residential for 5 days/ 4 nights, doing some activities with people they do not know and also they complete their Gold expedition in more demanding terrain. The school, with DoE South East, will help students to find a suitable provider for an expedition and training for them. The expeditions will take place usually in Snowdonia or the Lake District.
